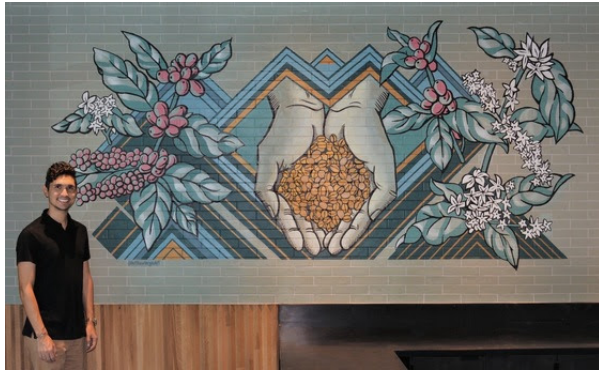


Sarasota Art Museum of Ringling College to Open 12/14/19

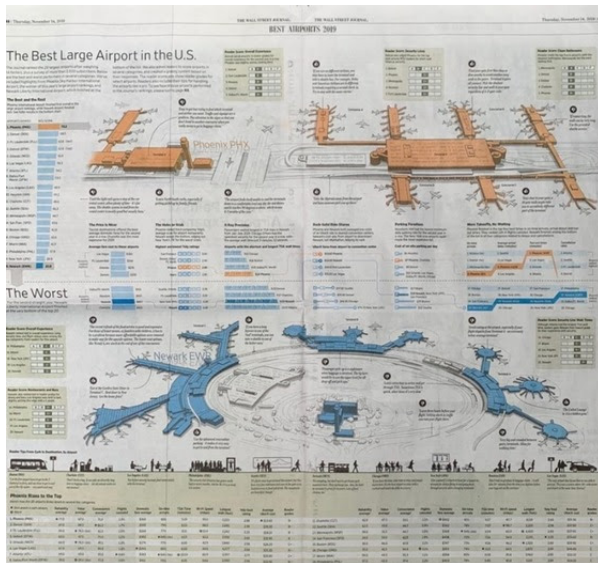


North Trail Starbucks Opens With Matthew Vargas '19 Mural

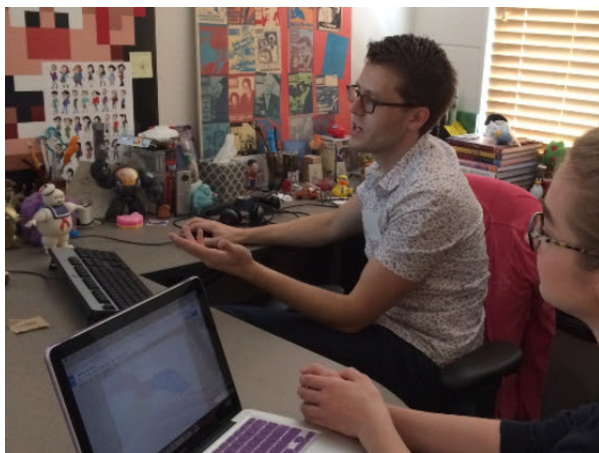
